RIVERSIDE WATER TOWER RESTORATION - Three separate structures designed by William LeBaron Jenney in 1870 are known as the Riverside Water Tower. Now fully restored, they serve as a cultural landmark, and house the Riverside History Museum. 45 Leaded and Antique Glass Windows were reproduced and restored in 2005 by Tiffany Stained Glass, Ltd.
